

**ATLANTIC COASTAL TOURISM DISTRICT OPPORTUNITY ZONE (ACTDOZ)
NATIONAL APPRENTICESHIP WEEK PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, the unprecedented efforts of the non-profit U.S. Humanitarian Aid Response Team CARES (U.S. HART CARES) have led to the formation of the Atlantic Coastal Tourism District Opportunity Zone (ACTDOZ) Mayoral Public Private Partnership (P3) Think Tank; and

WHEREAS, this unique strategic partnership will create and lead jointly managed initiatives dedicated to promoting advanced Data, RXT Cybersecurity, and Artificial Intelligence Apprenticeship Education and Workforce Training, along with expanding economic opportunities that will strengthen the goodwill and prosperity of ACTDOZ in the communities of Atlantic City, Brigantine, Longport, Margate, and Ventnor, and

WHEREAS, this unique collaboration will provide a pathway toward developing new non-casino RX5 Cybersecurity Apprenticeship Workforce Training within the ACTDOZ South Jersey Region; and

WHEREAS, the non-profit initiative led by U.S. HART CARES will focus on cooperative efforts and shared benefits that support the five Atlantic Coastal Cities' urgent RX5 Cybersecurity Apprenticeship Workforce Training needs, while leveraging incentives available through the Qualified Opportunity Zone; and


WHEREAS, ACTDOZ will seek strategic RX5 Cybersecurity Partnerships with key stakeholders, including the White House Cyber Strategy for America, Federal Government, United States Congress, the New Jersey Coastal Management Program, Casino Reinvestment Development Authority, the Atlantic City Casino Association, the William J. Hughes Technical Center for Advanced Aerospace, New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, the New Jersey Economic Development Agency, Stockton University, Atlantic Cape Community College, and the Jewish Family Services organization; and

WHEREAS, the initiative is designed to promote ACTDOZ entrepreneurial growth, expand RX5 Cyber Guardian Apprenticeship Workforce Training supported by federal and private partners, and ensure an equitable distribution of resources that ultimately benefits local taxpayers without costing them a single penny.
