Tariffs Effect on CRE Construction: What it Means for Skilled Trades



One year after new U.S. tariffs, construction materials cost about **6% more**, raising overall project costs by roughly **3%** compared to 2024. While prices are higher than before, they've stabilized from last year's peak—bringing more predictability to the market.

What this means for skilled trades:

- Strong, well-planned projects are still moving forward
- Skilled workers are more valued than ever for keeping jobs efficient and on schedule
- Productivity, teamwork, and experience are helping offset cost pressures

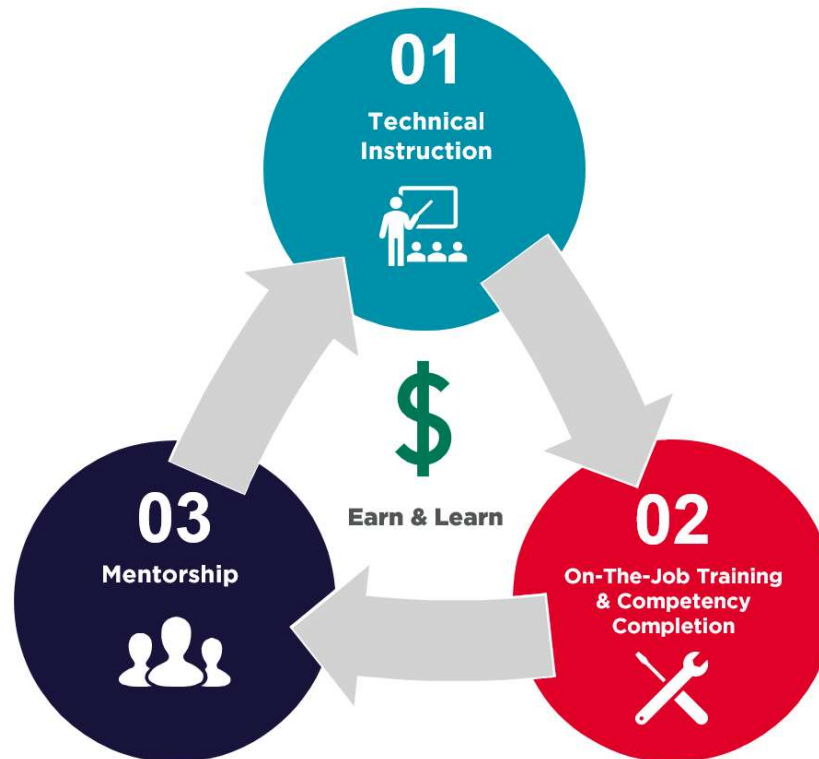
