## **PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, apprenticeship programs are uniquely able to meet the changing demands of Mississippi's economy and provide a path for all qualified individuals, including men, women, youth, people of color, rural communities, justice-involved individuals, and individuals with disabilities, to become apprentices and contribute to America's industries; and

WHEREAS, Mississippi recognizes and supports industry-driven youth apprenticeship programs, a proven training model to train our workforce, are a key part of the strategy to improve job quality and create access to good-paying, family-sustaining jobs for everyone, especially beginning with youth and young adults; and

**WHEREAS,** Mississippi is committed to strengthening talent development pipelines for all industry sectors that simultaneously open the doors of opportunity to youth and young adults – the future of our workforce.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Tate Reeves, as Governor of the State of Mississippi, do hereby proclaim May 5 - 11, 2024, as
