- Continue to leverage the expertise of the Department of Economic Opportunity, CareerSource Florida, and the Department of Education to develop a more robust workforce via an innovative and sustainable public-private partnership involving partnership of employers, industry organizations, educators, state and local workforce development systems, secondary and post-secondary institutions, and non-profit agencies.
