### Key ASE Expansion Strategies

- Expand state capacity by creating two new staff roles, documenting roles and responsibilities, delivering professional development, and providing subject matter-specific training opportunities.
  - Partner with Agency of Digital Services to develop an information management system, data collection and reporting process and manual, and staff training on information technology and new reporting requirements.
  - Develop participant, employer, and educator toolkits; create and publish audio, visual, and physical communication resources; deploy an apprenticeship website; conduct two webinars; and hold 12 regional trainings and outreach events.
  - Register seven new apprenticeship programs in in-demand occupations targeting underrepresented participants, conduct multilingual outreach, create a workforce partner system alignment map for each targeted population, and conduct apprenticeship training and education outreach to secondary and post-secondary career and technical education providers.
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
