Summary of program activities: (1) Strengthen the training infrastructure to deploy new and innovative RAPs in health care, advanced manufacturing, and information technology sectors, including Junior/Senior Developer RAPs; (2) Provide related technical instruction (RTI) by using grant funds to support pre-apprentices and apprentices (up to \$4,000 in tuition assistance per apprentice; total \$2,000,000); (3) Reimburse employers for On-the-Job-Training (up to \$2,100 per apprentice; total \$525,000); (4) Modify existing RAP classroom-based instruction so that it can be offered virtually to increase RAP access to rural populations; explore ways to leverage ongoing efforts to offer training programs using virtual reality (\$20,000), (5) engage employers and register new RAPs by working closely with Navigators/Intermediaries (\$500,000), and leverage existing and new partnerships to recruit and enroll youth, women, people of color, veterans, and persons with disabilities into RAPs (\$120,000).
