Tier I Baseline Goals

1. National Apprenticeship System Building.

Kansas will hire a new position, Registered Apprenticeship Grant Coordinator, to build on existing Registered Apprenticeship structure. Primary duties will include project management and assisting new apprenticeship programs develop standards.

2. System Alignment for Apprenticeship Expansion.

Kansas will host informational sessions to promote Registered Apprenticeship to education and workforce system entities, to include community colleges, Workforce Development Boards, Governors Education Council and others. Presentations will focus on increasing the number and quality of apprenticeships. Kansas will share information on social media, including Facebook, LinkedIn and other outlets.

3. Improving Data Sharing and Data Integrity.
