Tier I Baseline Goals

- 1. National Apprenticeship System Building- Increase the number of healthcare employer inquiries to the NJ Office of Apprenticeship Employer Engagement Unit
- 2. System Alignment-Develop a standardized process for referrals between one-stop career centers and Perkins CTE programs and RA sponsors to Increase the number of youth enrolled in registered apprenticeship state-wide by ten percent.
- **3. Improving Data Sharing-** *Improve data sharing between the New Jersey Office of Apprenticeship and the USDOL Office of Apprenticeship NJ representatives by developing an interface between their SalesForce systems.*

Our project will be dedicated to removing administrative and procedural barriers that hinder the expansion of registered apprenticeship. We will do this through the use of technology to facilitate data sharing between our office and our partners in USDOL. We will also create a standardized pathway for students to move form secondary pre-apprenticeship to Perkins CTE programs to registered apprenticeship. NJOA will have particular focus on the healthcare industry, and conduct additional outreach in this sector.
