Short Project Summary:

ApprenticeshipNC (ANC) is a State Apprenticeship Agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Labor and has outlined the baseline goals to include expansion activities addressing industry sectors such as advanced manufacturing, construction, healthcare and automobile industries. The goals and activities outlined in Tier I will add a Grant Administrator, Processing Assistant and Data Specialist to support our system infrastructure and help to expand apprenticeship programs in North Carolina.

ANC is currently administered through the NC Community College System Office. The NC Community College System office, located in Raleigh, NC, manages 58 community colleges across NC that supports more than 10 million citizens in the 100 counties across the State of NC. Additionally, ANC partners with the state's 23 Workforce Development Boards to better understand the support services offered by these agencies to serve the underrepresented community.

ApprenticeshipNC is also in the process of upgrading their apprenticeship programs tracking application which will be compatible with the RAPIDS system to help improve data sharing with the U. S. Department of Labor.
