PURPOSE: To inform Office of Apprenticeship Training, Employer and Labor Services (OATELS), Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training (BAT) Staff of the revision of subject Standards, and to transmit a copy of the revised document to Regional Directors only. BACKGROUND: The Foster Forbes Standards were initially registered on October 10, 1979, and the effective date of these revised standards (guidelines) is May 1, 1995.
