### Key ASE Expansion Strategies

- Engage youth at both the system level and program level to ensure broad engagement and active recruitment of highly motivated youth who are willing and committed to participate as registered apprentices in the various career tracks offered.
- Support apprenticeship training costs for sponsors and apprentices for related technical instruction and on-the-job learning.
- Provide computer supplies and a dedicated data specialist who will work to ensure data integrity, validity, and protection of confidential information while sharing data for evaluation purposes.
