  - Develop and implement policies and procedures at the American Job Center among the workforce and education system partners that will promote RAPs as a primary tool for workforce development and recruitment strategies for employers, as well as a career path for our youth, un/underemployed adults, our displaced/dislocated workers, and those most in need, with an emphasis on priority of services to veterans.
  - Develop a data sharing agreement among partner programs that addresses data collection and data reporting for respective partner programs.
  - Develop a procedure that ensures that all individual service activity is codified uniformly and accurately across all programs.
  - Update Guam's Eligible Training Programs/Providers List to include apprenticeship program opportunities and their sponsors as approved training assistance through Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act-funded programs.
  - Develop a statewide annual report on apprenticeship to include demographic information.
