Key ASE Expansion Strategies

- Increase outreach and awareness across the Commonwealth by holding an apprenticeship summit; attend events such as employer forums, conferences, graduations, etc.; and continue current work on employer engagement.
 - Increase capacity across Pennsylvania for apprenticeship by hiring three new apprenticeship staff and working with intermediaries, ambassador networks, and workforce development boards to grow their capacity and knowledge of apprenticeship.
 - Facilitate quarterly meetings with the Bureau of Workforce Partnerships and Operations to share apprenticeship information, collaborate, and focus on other possible collaborations with Commonwealth agencies.
 - Fund apprenticeship and pre-apprenticeship programs, and develop additional pools and pipelines to apprenticeship programs.
 - Identify nontraditional industries, and conduct outreach to employers in these sectors.
