Project Overview

The District 1199C Training & Upgrading Fund (the Training Fund) uses a collaborative approach to increase the use of Registered Apprenticeship (RA) within the care economy sector to help address challenges resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. This project creates a solution to workforce disruptions that have impacted the care economy sector (including childcare, homecare, and healthcare) by (1) reducing workforce turnover; (2) decreasing recruitment costs for employers; (3) increasing measurable skill gains for apprentices through the attainment of certifications, licenses, and degrees; (4) increasing workers' wages for traditionally low-paying jobs; and (5) improving the quality of care and client outcomes that result from a better-trained workforce. With its partners, the Training Fund is supporting the expansion of RA within the care economy sector across the country.

Types of Services or Technical Assistance (TA) Provided

- Conduct outreach and recruitment of employers, associations, and apprentices
- Support partners with the development and registration of RA models and standards
- Focus on the in-demand care economy sector by creating resource pipelines meant to assist programs with accessing funding and recruiting participants
- Incentivize qualifying programs with funds that will support the development of standards and the costs associated with starting an initial cohort of apprentices
