ECEPTS will develop non-traditional Registered Apprenticeships for a diverse workforce that fill essential Care Economy roles that are traditionally underpaid and undervalued. ECEPTS recasts entrylevel Early Care and Education (ECE) jobs as pathways to careers that provide competitive wages and career advancement in ECE.

Types of Services or Technical Assistance (TA) Provided

- Create and promote apprenticeships in non-traditional ECE occupations
- Incorporate attainment of ECE industry credentials into each Registered Apprenticeship (RA) programs' Related Technical Instruction (RTI) and On-the Job Training standards
- Facilitate access to career advancement opportunities and associated wage increases
- Collaborate with employer partners and industry subject matter experts to advance the development of RA programs
- Align RTI and pre-apprenticeship training to meet the requirements of successful RA entry
