Project Overview

H-CAP works with partners to create and implement high-quality Registered Apprenticeship (RA) programs. H-CAP confronts occupational segregation within the healthcare industry by creating opportunities for low-wage healthcare workers and healthcare workers of color to advance into high-paid jobs. H-CAP takes a hands-on approach to collaborating with Federal and State Offices of Apprenticeship, stakeholders, sponsors, and employers to educate employers and build RAs from the ground up. The goal is to identify high-need occupations and build RA programs that can sustainably provide a diverse pool of skilled workers.

Types of Services or Technical Assistance (TA) Provided

- Provide TA to develop RAs, free of charge
- Design and launch strategies to recruit and retain a skilled and diverse workforce
- Develop On-The-Job Learning competencies for each occupation
- Provide training for apprenticeship mentors
- Support partners to ensure compliance with EEO requirements
- Partner with education providers and workforce systems to progress RA initiatives
