<p>Summary of Youth Apprenticeship Program Activities and List of Credential(s) to be Awarded:</p>	<p>AMIKids, Inc. will leverage its existing vocational training program for youth to become a Florida Registered Pre-Apprenticeship Program. This program will enroll at least 500 participants over 48 months, with a minimum of 400 entering a Registered Apprenticeship Program. Recruited participants will be assessed, provided support services, and placed into Pre-Apprenticeship at AMIKids Pinellas, AMIKids Tampa, and AMIKids YES in which they may earn the NCCER Core and OSHA 10 certifications and/or a GED. Participants will then be placed in a job with a partner employer and gain facilitated entry through articulation agreements with Construction Trade RAP partner programs. Participants who complete these RAPs will earn stackable industry-recognized certifications and journeyman credentials in their respective occupations.</p>
