Executives from transcription employers, of various sizes, have indicated their support via printed comment.

This occupation clearly lends itself to the structured On-the-Job Learning and Related Technical Instruction of Registered Apprenticeship. Workers must go into the position with extensive knowledge of medical terminology, acquired through technical instruction via an educational provider. Furthermore, they must produce reports on-the-job, with quality assurance oversight and feedback, in order to gain proficiency and productivity through the range of medical situations and practitioners from which they transcribe.
