**BACKGROUND:** Regional Director Jill Houser, on behalf of the Northeast Biomanufacturing Center and Collaborative, submitted this apprenticeability request for the occupation Microbiology Quality Control Technician. The duties of a Microbiology Quality Control Technician include: Performing routine microbiological testing of raw materials, in-process samples and finished formulations according to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). Conducting routine environmental monitoring of good manufacturing practices, manufacturing areas, equipment and processes according to established procedures. Calibrating and maintaining microbiology laboratory equipment. Compiling and analyzing data for documentation of test results and preparing related reports. Revise and update SOPs as necessary.
